ENTRY: Entries close Aug. 4. Entries must be postmarked by this date. **Any late entries are subject to double entry fees and prior approval of the Superintendent.** You may submit your entries online. **Online deadline is Aug. 8.** Payment must be made with entry. Only Visa and MasterCard accepted online. www.idahofair.com. A \$2 per exhibitor convenience fee applies.

- The Management reserves the right to close entries **whenever** available space is filled. Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Western Idaho Fair.
- FEES:** \$1.50 per **RABBIT OR CAVY**, \$1.50 fur class, \$1.50 per single fryer and \$1.50 per meat pen.
No refund on entry fees.
- PASSES:** Since exhibitors in this department are not required to come in daily to care for their animals, they may purchase **up to** ten single day passes at \$5.00 each **or** two 5 day passes at \$20.00 each. (They cannot purchase both 5 day and single day passes.) **Remittance** for entry fees and exhibitor passes **must accompany entries.**
- PARKING:** Each exhibitor will be given **ONE** vehicle parking permit. See General Rules and Information on page 4 or Website under General Rules for more information and a map of the vehicle parking areas.
- Small Animal Building Hours** will be Noon to 10:00 p.m. unless opened early for judging events or check-in.
- CAMPING:** See General Rules and information on page 4 or Website under General Rules.
- ARRIVAL:** Wednesday, Aug. 23 – **Rabbits & Cavies** will have a health check by a veterinarian before check-in from 7:00 a.m. to 10 a.m. **Vehicles inside the paid admission area must be removed to the livestock vehicle parking area before 11:00 a.m. Push carts or hand trucks will make transport of animals much easier. Fair personnel will assist with transport from vehicle parking area if needed.**
- JUDGING:** Each breed will show separately. See appropriate department for judging times. A judging schedule will be posted in the show room.
- RELEASE:** Exhibits will be released from **8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.** on Sunday, Aug. 27. Exhibits must be picked up

- by 10:00 p.m. **Release Slips** will be issued by the Department Superintendent and will be required for transportation of livestock from the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors leaving early without permission of the Superintendent will forfeit all awards due them.
- CARE:** Feed, watering and care of your exhibits will be done by the Western Idaho Fair if marked at check-in. No person shall handle any exhibits without the permission of the Superintendent or the owner. See Superintendent for more information.
- Exhibitors are requested to read the **General Rules** in the front of this Premium Book and/or Website. The Management reserves the right to substitute Judges and to interpret Rules and decide all questions not covered in the General Rules.
- All exhibits are entered and shown at the risk of the owner.** While all reasonable care will be exercised in the handling and protection of exhibits, the Officials, Superintendent or the Western Idaho Fair will in no case be responsible for loss. **Entry is deemed acceptance of the rules** in this Premium Book.
- COMPETITION:** Competition is defined as a contest for supremacy between two or more animals or articles or products owned by separate exhibitors. Two or more exhibits entered by the same person or household do not constitute competition.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

Rabbits and Cavies must be sound, in good health, and free of communicable diseases. Out-of-state rabbits and cavies must have a Certificate of Veterinary inspection dated no earlier than 30 days prior to the Western Idaho Fair. All animals are subject to inspection at the Fairgrounds.

(Judging order to be announced at check in)

1. Each exhibitor may enter up to 20 rabbits and 20 cavies, but not more than 60 per family/household, in the Rabbit and Cavy department. If an exhibitor would like to enter more rabbits or cavies, they must send a statement with their entries stating how many more they would like to enter. The Superintendent will notify the exhibitor after all late entries are received as to how many extra animals they will be allowed to enter. No late fee will be charged if the statement was received before original closing date for entries.
2. Official entry forms must include **Department #, Division #, Class # and Ear #** for each entry. See “Entry” and “Fees” listed above. Contact the Superintendent with any questions about class designation for entries. Entry changes will be accepted through Saturday, Aug. 19 10:00 p.m. After Aug. 19, only ear # change will be accepted through check-in. No changes accepted after check-in times. **If possible, notify Superintendent of any scratched entries before check in. All scratches must be submitted in writing at check in.**
3. Entries judged within American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) showroom classes. ARBA showroom classes are organized by breed, variety and class.
4. All rabbits must be identified by a permanent tattoo in the left ear. Freshly tattooed rabbits must have the excess ink removed before check in. Rabbits with illegible tattoos may be disqualified at the discretion of the judge. Cavies must have tattoo or ARBA approved ear tags.
5. Rabbits and Cavies must be shown in the name of the current owner when entries are made. Bunnies entered must be at least 8 weeks old or meet the minimum weight requirement stated in the ARBA Standard of Perfection. Cavies entered must weigh at least 12 ounces. **No animals are allowed in the building unless entered in the Fair.**
6. Trough drinking is provided but it is recommended that you bring your own water containers or water bottles.
7. Locks may be used on the cages but must not damage the cages in any way. Any damage to the cages will be charged to the exhibitor at check-out time. Exhibitors may lock cages with cable or zip ties. Exhibitors must provide their own ties.
8. Carriers will be available to take rabbits from unlocked cages to the show table for judging. Rabbits in locked pens will not be judged. Ties will be cut for judging.

9. **This is a sanctioned ARBA show.** It will be governed by the latest ARBA show rules and regulations in cooperation with the Western Idaho Fair. Only recognized ARBA breeds will be judged in classes listed in the Standard of Perfection or ARBA recognized working breeds or varieties. The National Convention of ARBA for 2017 will be held in Indianapolis, IN, Oct. 1 - 5, 2017. To join ARBA contact: Eric Stewart, Executive Director, Box 5667, Bloomington, IL 61702. 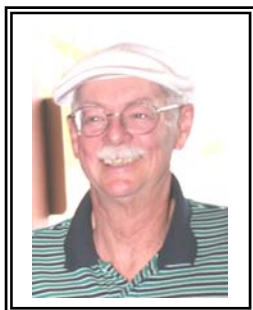

- PARKING:** Each exhibitor will be given **ONE** vehicle parking permit. See General Rules and Information on page 4 or Website under General Rules for more information and a map of the vehicle parking areas.
- Small Animal Building Hours** will be Noon to 10:00 p.m. unless opened early for judging events or check-in.
- CAMPING:** See General Rules and information on page 4 or Website under General Rules.
- ARRIVAL:** Wednesday, Aug. 23 – **Pigeons & Poultry** will be checked in from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Pigeons may also be checked in Tuesday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. (Poultry may not enter the building until they have been tested and inspected.) **Vehicles inside the paid admission area must be removed to the livestock vehicle parking area before 11:00 a.m. Push carts or hand trucks will make transport of animals much easier. Fair personnel will assist with transport from vehicle parking area if needed.**
- JUDGING:** Each breed will show separately. See appropriate department for judging times. A judging schedule will be posted in the show room.
- RELEASE:** Exhibits will be released from **8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.** on Sunday, Aug. 27. Exhibits must be picked up by 10:00 p.m. **Release Slips** will be issued by the Department Superintendent and will be required for transportation of livestock from the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors leaving early without permission of the Superintendent will forfeit all awards due them.
- CARE:** Feed, watering and care of your exhibits will be done by the Western Idaho Fair. No person shall handle any exhibits without the permission of the Superintendent or the owner.
- Exhibitors are requested to read the **General Rules** in the front of this Premium Book and/or Website. The Management reserves the right to substitute Judges and to interpret Rules and decide all questions not covered in the General Rules.
- All exhibits are entered and shown at the risk of the owner.** While all reasonable care will be exercised in the handling and protection of exhibits, the Officials, Superintendent or the Western Idaho Fair will in no case be responsible for loss. **Entry is deemed acceptance of the rules** in this Premium Book.
- COMPETITION:** Competition is defined as a contest for supremacy between two or more animals or articles or products owned by separate exhibitors. Two or more exhibits entered by the same person or household do not constitute competition.

14. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

POULTRY

Poultry must be sound, in good health, and free of communicable diseases. Poultry **are required** to be tested negative for **Salmonella pullorum-typhoid** or originate from flocks which are members of the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). Pullorum-typhoid testing will be available during check in. Poultry may not enter the building until they have been tested and inspected.

All **out-of-state** poultry must meet Idaho import requirements and be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated no earlier than 30 days prior to arrival at the Western Idaho Fair and tested negative for Salmonella pullorum-typhoid, Salmonella enteritidis, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma synoviae. Out-of-state Turkeys must be tested for Mycoplasma meleagridis. All poultry are subject to inspection at the Fairgrounds.

PIGEONS AND DOVES

Pigeons and Doves must be sound, in good health, and free of communicable diseases. It is recommended that all pigeons be vaccinated for PMV and paratyphoid. All out-of-state pigeons must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated no earlier than 30 days prior to arrival at the Western Idaho Fair. All pigeons and doves are subject to inspection at the Fairgrounds.

1. **This is a Sanctioned Club APA (American Poultry Association) Club Meet.** All standard birds will be judged by the APA Standard of Perfection. The APA invites you to become a member. Adult dues are \$20/1 year or \$50/3 years. Junior dues (for those 18 and under) are \$15/1 year or \$40/3 years. Adult members receive the yearbook and are eligible to earn Master Exhibitor points at sanctioned shows. All members receive the quarterly newsletter and are eligible for the awards at this show. Mike Stanton is the APA District representative.

The minimum number of Master Exhibitor points for a qualified win at this show is 5.

MEDAL AWARDS: An APA Medal will be awarded to the Champion Bird in each of the following classes when ten (10) or more birds are judged in the class:

Large Chickens: American, Asiatic, English, Mediterranean, Continental & All Other Standard Breeds.

Bantams: Modern Game, Old English Game, Single Comb Clean Legged (Other than Game), Rose Comb Clean Legged, All Other Combs Clean Legged & Feather Legged.

Ducks: Heavy, Medium, Light & Bantam

Geese: Heavy, Medium & Light

Turkeys: All recognized breeds

Game birds: Pheasant-Quail-Partridge

CERTIFICATE AWARDS: When ten (10) or more are judged, certificates will be given for each of the following: Grand & Reserve Champion Large Chicken, Grand & Reserve Champion Bantam, Grand & Reserve Champion Duck, Grand & Reserve Champion Goose and Champion & Reserve Champion Turkey.

JUNIOR AWARDS: A medal plus a one year Junior membership will be given to the Juniors showing the Champion Large Chicken, the Champion Bantam and the Champion of Ducks, Geese and Turkeys combined. Juniors need not be members to receive Junior awards.

Best of Breed ribbons have been furnished to the show. Winners of these ribbons need not be APA members.

All judging shall be by the latest edition of the **American Standard of Perfection**, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association, Inc.

2. **This is a North American Hamburg Society Area Meet.** The North American Hamburg Society Area Meets earn points toward the North American Hamburg Society Exhibitor of the year awards. To be eligible for the above points, exhibitors must be members of the club prior to judging. Yearly membership fees are: Individual - \$15, Family - \$18, Junior - \$10. Members receive a quarterly newsletter, a breeder's directory and are eligible for awards offered by the club. If you are not already a member of the North American Hamburg Society, please write to the Treasurer: Jim LeGendre, 95393 Grimes Road, Junction City, Oregon 97448.
3. All birds will be awarded ribbons and premiums on the quality of the bird. **Decision of the Judge will be final.** Only Blue Ribbon birds qualify for Best of Breed or Variety.
4. **Age Division** – Birds hatched prior to Jan. 1 of current year will be classified as cocks and hens. Birds hatched after Jan. 1 will be classified as cockerels and pullets.
5. **Leg Bands** – All birds must be banded with a numbered leg band. Birds will not be accepted unless properly banded. Number must be stated on entry blank.
6. Birds must be the property of the exhibitor a minimum of 90 days preceding the Fair.
7. Old and Young trios will not compete against each other.
8. **Egg Division** – An entry consists of six eggs. All six eggs should be as close to each other in size, color, weight and freshness as possible. The owner may designate one egg to be broken by the judge. Entry fee per class is \$1.50

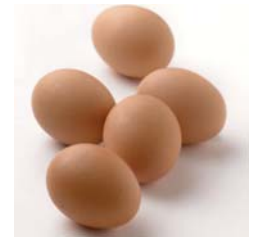

JUDGING: All Breeds: Thursday, Aug. 24 – 11:00 a.m.

1. All breeds will be judged by the APA standard of Perfection
2. **Leg Bands:** This show is conducted under the rules that recognize all seamless bands of reputable banding organizations. Young birds must wear official bands of the proper size and year, issued by any club or organization. All birds must wear some kind of regulation numbered band. If split bands are used, birds will be classed as old birds.
3. **Disqualifications:** The right is reserved for the superintendent or judges to disqualify sick or unworthy specimens. Each specimen must be bona fide property of the exhibitor and show in its natural condition. Conversation with the judge by exhibitors is prohibited during the judging, except by the show management. A violation of this rule disqualifies the exhibitor's birds.
4. **All birds will be caged on Tuesday, Aug. 22 from 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, Aug. 23 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Vehicles must be removed from inside fairgrounds before 11:00 a.m. See Rule #7 on page 55.**
5. **ENTRIES:** Entries close Aug 4. Entries must be postmarked by this date. Entry fee is \$2.00 per bird and \$5.00 per show team. Late entries will be charged a double entry fee. Late entries will not be accepted after Aug. 8 unless given special permission by the department Superintendent. **Exhibitors in Department 11D should refer to General Rules 1-14 at the beginning of the Small Animals Department.**
6. All breeds, in addition to division, should state "color" to allow for the structuring of color classes within breeds.
7. Show Racing Homer and Open Class Racing Homer color classes are blue checks, blue bars, red checks, red bars, grizzles, rare colors, splashes, indigo and open.
8. Flying Rollers, in addition to being entered as either American, Birmingham or Baldhead should also state color. Color classes for all Rollers are Light Tortoise, Medium Tortoise, Dark Tortoise, Marked, Checked, Barred, Grizzle, Self and Rare. There is also a certified Spinner Class. Certificates must be presented upon request.
9. Show Rollers are a special class and should be so designated on entry. Use same color class designation as Flying Rollers.
10. Classes are provided for flown and diploma racing homers and are based on mileage flown. A bird may be shown only in the class in which it is entered.
11. Flown Racing Homer classes are: (0-100 Miles)-(101-200 Miles)-(201-300 Miles)-(301-400 Miles)-(401-500 Miles)-(501 and over).
12. Diploma classes are: (0-100 Miles)-(101-200 Miles)-(201-300 Miles)-(301-400 Miles)-(401-500 Miles)-(501 and over).
13. Race Sheets and Diplomas must be provided upon request.
14. Every attempt will be made to place pigeons in the proper color classes. However, birds entered in the wrong color class will be docked color points according to standard.
