**How to enter:**

Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days, you have the following 2 options:

- 354. Creamed Honey – two 1 pint glass jars, unlabeled
- 355. Comb Honey – cut, 2 samples, rectangle or round, unlabeled
- 356. Comb Honey – chunk, 2 samples, one strip of comb in each of two 1 pint jars, unlabeled
- 357. Framed Honey – Submit single frame in display case
- 358. Exhibition (**Ribbons only, no premiums**): Submit one. Candles, cosmetics, soaps, tinctures, infused honey, photography (photo must display bees and/or bee yard).
