All Artwork must be ready to hang with a **suitable wire** hanger. Sawtooth hangers can not be accepted due to the hanging process. (Please, no string, yarn, thin wire, tape or glue). Wrapped canvasses are accepted as long as the edges are painted accordingly. All work must be completely dry. Glass or Plexiglas is suggested to protect water and dry mediums. Please sign your artwork.

Painting: Oil, Acrylic, Casein, Watercolor, Tempera or any opaque painting media.

Fine Arts Sculpture: Sculpture may be any permanent medium. Any subject. Must not exceed 300 lbs.

DIVISION 5 – COMPUTER ART – AMATEUR

Work must be completely original; no scanning of published works i.e. Anime/Super Hero characters etc., no plagiarism. Include a brief description of your process. All Artwork must be ready to hang with a **suitable wire** hanger. Sawtooth hangers cannot be accepted due to the hanging process. (Please, no string, yarn, thin wire, tape or glue). Artwork must be signed.

DIVISION 3 – PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL AND INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES

Same rules for hanging art work as the Amateur Division. Please sign your artwork.

Premiums: 1st-\$25 2nd-\$20 3rd-\$10 Honorable Mention-Ribbon

Class:

- 1D. Paintings – Oil, Acrylic, Casein, Watercolor, Tempera or any opaque painting media.
- 2D. Other Media – Pastels, Charcoal, Pencil or Ink, etc.
- 3D. Mixed Media – A mixture of two or more media; i.e. watercolor and colored pencil.
- 4D. All 3 Dimensional

All Artwork must be ready to hang with **suitable picture wire hanger and firmly attached screw eyes**. Sawtooth hangers can not be accepted due to hanging process. (Please no string, yarn, thin wire, tape or glue). All work must be completely dry. Wrapped canvas paintings will be allowed. However, wrapped edges must be painted appropriately. Glass or Plexiglas is suggested to protect water and dry mediums.
No one other than the Fine Arts staff is permitted in the display area during Check-in, Judging and on Release Day due to **safety** precautions.

How to enter:

Bring in your entries with the entry form(s) to the Fairgrounds on **Monday, Aug. 13 or Tuesday, Aug. 14 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days, you have the following 2 options:

3. **a)** Mail or deliver **ONLY** your **entry form(s)** to the Premium Office, 5610 Glenwood, Boise ID 83714 by **August 9.**
