Open to both Professional and Amateur. All instruments must be made by hand from a pattern or of your own design.

#### **DIVISION 21 – HANDCRAFTED DOLLS**

Open to both Professional and Amateur. No commercially manufactured clothing or accessories will be accepted as any part of the entry and will need to be removed before entering the exhibit.

#### **DIVISION 22 – GLASS WORK**

Open to both Professional and Amateur. All items entered may be from a pattern or your own design.

**Class:**
