DIVISION 26 – MODELS - AMATEUR

Judging and display set up requires projects to be moved after entry. Every precaution will be taken for project safety, but please insure that your models are securely constructed. We suggest that models be mounted on a solid base and/or wheels to be blocked to facilitate safe display.

No repairs or adjustments will be allowed after entry.

DIVISION 27 – LEGO PROJECTS

Model should be mounted on baseplate attached to solid base with no loose parts or mini figs. **Size limit** of 15"x15"x20" no larger than a 48"x48" stud base plate. Entries must be original design.
