How to enter:

Bring your entries with the entry form(s) to the fairgrounds on **Monday, Aug. 13 or Tuesday Aug. 14 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days, you have the following 2 options:

- 1.a.** Mail or deliver **ONLY** your **entry form (s)** to the Premium Office, 5610 Glenwood, Boise, ID 83714 by **Aug. 9.**
- b.** Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on **Aug. 13 or Aug. 14** from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- or 2.a.** Enter online by **Aug. 9** at www.idahofair.com. Follow the link to Competitive Exhibits. A \$2 fee will apply. This fee is per exhibitor, regardless of number of entries or in how many departments you enter.
- b.** Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on **Aug. 13 or Aug. 14** from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Entries will be received in the **NORTH WING** of the Exposition Building.

RELEASE: Monday, Aug. 27-10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

- 2. Entries should have been finished in the last 12 months and be **clean** at time of entry.

- 388. Any crochet item
- 389. Any knit item

- 393. Pillow, other – to age 10
- 394. Pillow, other – ages 11 & 12
- 395. Picture, any needlework

QUILTS: Two pieces of fabric with batting between

- 396. Quilt, quilted by hand
- 397. Quilt, quilted with machine by entrant
- 398. Quilt, pieced or stitched by exhibitor, professionally quilted
- 399. Comforter (2 layers of fabric) layers are tied or otherwise connected, but not quilted
- 400. Fleece comforter, may be one layer or two
- 401. Wall hanging (no larger than 36"x36")
- 402. Stuffed toy – to age 10
- 403. Stuffed toy – ages 11 & 12
- 404. Clothing – ages 12 & younger
- 405. Doll clothes
- 406. Miscellaneous-any item not listed above-to age 10 – apron, pillowcase, bags, etc.
- 407. Miscellaneous-any item not listed above-ages 11-12 – apron, pillowcase, bags, etc.
