

DAIRY REPLACEMENT HEIFER PROJECT SALE!



OPTIONS INCLUDE

1) Outright Purchase.

Purchase high quality heifer to add to the herd.

Example:

- Bid: \$1400
- Buyer Pays: \$1400

2) Purchase and resell as donation to the youth.

Pay the difference between purchase price and market price.

Example:

- Bid: \$1800 - Re-sell Value: \$1200 = Buyer Pays Donation \$600

3) Dairy Heifer Fund.

Donation to specific youth's heifer or to general Dairy Heifer Fund.

Example:

- \$200 to be added to Suzy Q's heifer.
- OR \$500 to be placed in the pool which will ensure that all youth receive reasonable support.

The Treasure Valley Dairy Replacement Heifer Project, open to youth from several counties, aims to enhance knowledge of the dairy industry and develop life skills. Participants purchase and manage a heifer calf for approximately 16 months, learning about financing, budgeting, record-keeping, nutritional and reproductive management, and showmanship. They present their heifers at the Western Idaho Fair, where the animals are evaluated and sold. Community support is crucial to help cover the significant costs and support the participants' future endeavors.
